# Follow up

on outstanding application matters

## Overseas University Application

### ② Apply

#### Settle application

- Attend briefing in TJC (23 May)
- Draft personal statement
- Liaise with Coordinator (Submit TJC UK/ US Form 2024)
- Liaise with referee(s)
- Make payment online when all relevant sections are completed to enable submission (by Coordinator (UK) / by self (US))
- Attend to any prerequisites (admission tests, transcripts, etc)

**Notify early** of your intent to study abroad

### ③ Prepare

#### Settle outstanding matters

- Monitor correspondence / email
- Prepare for any interview
- Settle any outstanding submission of documents (transcripts, test scores, portfolios, etc)
- Notify Coordinator of acceptance outcome where possible
